Day Camp Policies (Please read and keep pages 3 & 4)

Eligibility and Operational information:

- All school age children who have completed Kindergarten (5K) through 8th grade is eligible to attend camp
- Child must complete Kindergarten by May 2020 to register
- Operates Monday-Friday 6:30am to 6:00pm
- Please do not arrive before 6:30am or pick up after 6:00. Late pick up will result in additional fees of \$2.50 for every five minutes late for pick up

Registration Fees

- **RETURNING 2019 CAMPERS ONLY:** A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 per child
- **NEW FAMILIES:** A non-refundable registration fee of \$75.00 per child
- **NEW FAMILY SIBLING RATE:** \$70.00 per child

Rate Options

- Weekly option rate (only available on Mondays of each week) \$90.00 per child, pays for Mon-Fri care for the week
- Any day after Monday is a drop-in rate of \$25.00 per child
- Fees are due at drop off each morning cash, checks and credit cards are accepted
- Make checks payable to: ALMDC
- Credit cards include 4% transaction fee
- \$10.00 non-sufficient fund fee charged for every returned check
- Credits from the previous summer do not carry over

Field Trips:

- Refer to calendar for field trip dates and times
- **ARRIVE ONE HOUR BEFORE LISTED FIELD TRIP TIME:** Children who miss the bus stay at camp
- Field trips are subject to cancel/change without notice
- Be sure to mark deep water swimming permission (questions asked after child signature line)
- If your child requires a life jacket they will be required to swim only in the shallow end.
- ALMDC does not supply life jackets, please send with your child if you want them to wear one
- DHS requires all children to wear sunscreen; please provide your child with spray type sunscreen
- Make sure your child has sunscreen, towel, change of clothes, bag for wet clothes and pool shoes on swim days
- Please arrive with swimsuit/trunks under clothes
- Please do not send goggles or pool toys
- Label all of your child's belongings, ALMDC is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Children are transported by ALMDC buses for all field trips
- Children CANNOT be dropped off/picked up by parent from field trip

Snacks/Hot Lunches/afternoon concession

- Morning snack provided by Day Camp
- Afternoon concession is optional: children without punch cards will receive pretzels, animal crackers or veggie straws
- Day Camp cannot accept any children who have epi-pen allergies due to food brought in from outside sources
- When packing your child's lunch please use the U.S.D.A guidelines at www.health.gov/dietaryguidelines.com
- An insulated lunchbox with icepacks will keep foods and milk from spoiling
- Please do not send food in your child's lunchbox that requires use of a microwave
- All hot lunches are \$2.00 and includes a pouch drink
- Check calendar for hot meal of the week
- All Concession items are \$1.00 each: Ice Cream and sodas available for purchases
- Punch cards are purchased at the front desk in \$10.00 increments, more than one punch card can be purchased at a time
- Each punch is worth \$1.00 so for a \$10.00 punch card your child has \$10.00 to spend on hot lunches or afternoon concession. ***PUNCH CARDS ARE ONLY PURCHASED AT THE FRONT DESK AND ONLY USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF HOT LUNCHES OR AFTERNOON CONCESSION***

Drop off/pick up

- For any pick-up restrictions please supply appropriate legal documentation for your child's file. ALMDC will not be involved in custody battles proper legal papers must be supplied and state the custody restriction involved.
- No child will be permitted to leave ALMDC with any person other than the person authorized by parent/guardian present. ID will be required to confirm authorization of pick-up.

- All children must be signed in/out daily by parent/guardian at drop off and pick up
- Children cannot be dropped off or picked up at field trip sites-DHS requirement
- No outside visitors allowed to visit on pool days, the pool is closed to the public during our time of swimming

DHS Licensing requirements

- 201.2 PG. 21 It is the responsibility of all ALMMDO employees to report any suspected abuse or neglect of a child to the appropriate child protective service agency.
- 201.4 PG. 22 Children are subject to be interviewed by licensing staff, child maltreatment investigators and/or law enforcement officials for the purpose of determining compliance or for investigative purposes. (Child interviews do not require parental notice or consent.)
- 501.2 PG. 32 Physical punishments shall not be administered to children.
- 1101.27 PG. 50 Children shall be protected from overexposure to the sun. Sunscreen shall be used if needed and as directed by the parent. Suntan lotions and/or sunscreens used for infants/toddlers and preschool children shall be kept out of the children's reach and shall be administered only with written parental permission.

Health/Illness

- Child must be 100% potty trained parent will be called if child has bathroom accident.
- Children who have vomiting, diarrhea, fever, lethargic, unknown/contagious rash or other contagious illness cannot attend day camp until they are 24-hour symptom free without medication
- Parent/guardians must notify the ALMDC Director if a child has been diagnosed with communicable disease
- Medications shall be given to children only with signed, written permission. All medication has to be in the original container, not expired, and labeled with the appropriate child's name. Dosages greater than specified on the label shall not be given. All medications must be given to the front desk they are not allowed to be stored in backpacks or lockers.
- I hereby request and give my consent to the director, ALMDC or duly appointed representative for the child to receive medical or surgical aid, CPR, or anything deemed necessary and expedient by a daily licensed or recognized physician in case of an emergency when the parent/guardian or other emergency contact should be reached. I will not hold ALMDC responsible for the emergency care or transportation for the above-named child or any other expenses other than what is covered by ALMDC insurance

Day Camp Offenses:

- **Inappropriate words**
- **Prejudice words**
- **Hitting, pushing or yelling at other campers**
- **Disrespectful behavior toward camp staff**
- **Running from ALMDC staff and not staying with the group**
- **Threatening language**
- **Destruction of ALMDC property**
- **Displaying games on electronics that use profanity, violence or dishonor to God**
- **Use of electronics (phone, iPad) outside of designated electronic times and places**
- **Using phones to make calls, text or take pictures during camp hours (electronics are for games only)**
- **Any other behavior that disrupt daily camp activities**

Discipline:

- Staff are advised to report to Director any behavior issues that cause disruptions to camp
- Reported behavior concerns require behavior report and signature from both parent and Director
- Child is also required to sign behavior report forms. WE PROMOTE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY
- 3 written offenses equal 3 days of suspension from camp
- ALMDC reserves the right to discontinue services for the remainder of the summer if behavior continues
